Shadow was surrendered to The Chautauqua County Humane Society after being bounced through several homes with changing life circumstances. Just before Shadow was brought to CCHS, he got loose and came back with a wounded paw.

After being surrendered, Shadow began receiving regular care, and as you can see in the photo above, CCHS staff and volunteers signed his first bandages to show him how loved he was. X-rays were done and showed that Shadow had a broken radius and ulna, but thankfully, at the time this was written, he was showing signs of proper healing.

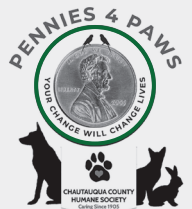
